

'Sometimes I Laugh Like My Sister' - a production by Vltal Digression and Obviam Est

Technical Rider

STAGE

Minimum playing area: 5m (width) x 3.5m (depth).

No wings or backdrop required, but if they are present this presents no problem for the production.

SET & PROPS

One drinking glass and one jug with water.

One simple small table (or similar) that is large enough to hold the jug and the glass.

One simple chair, preferably dark colour.

LIGHTING

A general light (general wash) for the whole stage area is required (quiet cold or just white).

If it is possible, back lights (dark blue). A vertical spot (white) above the chair –which should have a separate channel from the general lighting.

DRESSING ROOM

A dressing room for one person is required with enough light and a mirror for make-up.

A jug of tap water and a glass would be appreciated.

If there are any problems with the above requirements please contact us as we are sure we can find a solution!
